



John C. Harvey

John C. Harvey, Jr., a retired U.S. Navy Admiral, was sworn-in as Virginia's Secretary of Veterans Affairs and Homeland Security in January 2014. By legislation signed on March 3, 2014, Governor McAuliffe renamed and refocused



Secretary Harvey's post, which is now the Secretary of Veterans and Defense Affairs. As Secretary, Harvey is responsible for the oversight of all veterans-related issues in Virginia, executed through the Department of Veteran Services, and ensuring that a productive relationship is maintained with the military services and Department of Defense activities located within the Commonwealth.
