The **TRUCK DRIVER TRAINING PROGRAM** gives students the opportunity to acquire the skills necessary to obtain successful, well-paid careers as professional truck drivers.

TOPICS INCLUDE:

- Department of Transportation rules and regulations
- Defensive driving
- Truck/trailer maintenance
- Hazardous materials
- Backing the tractor/trailer
- Over-the-road and city driving

The 270 hours of instruction are broken down to 60 hours of classroom and personal instruction, and 210 hours of practical application. In order to receive a certificate, a passing grade in the following courses must be received:

TRK 101 – DOT Safety Rules and Regulations
(2 credits)

TRK 102 – Preventive Maintenance for
Truck Drivers (1 credit)

TRK 103 – Tractor Trailer Driving (9 credits)

TRK 110 – Survey of the Trucking Industry
(3 credits)

SDV 106 – Preparation for Employment
(1 credit)

Students will earn a Career Studies Certificate
(Class A Truck Driving (16 credits)

- b. Over-the-Road (OTR) driving
- c. Short Haul driving
