Work Opportunity Tax Credit

The Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) is a federal tax credit available to all private sector businesses. It is an incentive for employers to hire individuals in certain targeted groups who consistently experience high rates of unemployment due to a variety of employment barriers.

On-the-Job Training

The Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) program is available to workers who lose their jobs or whose hours of work and wages are reduced as a result of foreign competition.

You can save money by hiring TAA-eligible trainees through On-the-Job Training. You customize the training to meet your business needs, and training costs are reimbursed by the VEC.

Other On-the-Job Training programs are also available through our partner organizations. Programs available and levels of reimbursement vary in different areas. Contact your local workforce center for details.

Access to Qualified Military Veterans

The VEC assists between 13,000 and 15,000 veterans annually in securing employment, depending on the economy and employer demand. The VEC can help you recruit well-qualified veterans. We have staff members dedicated to assisting you in a workforce center near you. If you have federal contracts or you need the skills, knowledge, and ability that military experience provides, our veterans service representatives can help you.

If hiring veterans is important to your company, you can add your company name to our online list of Military Friendly Employers.

Online Unemployment Insurance Services

- File an Appeal of Deputy Determination or an Appeal of the Appeals Examiner's Decision.
- Precedent Decision Manual - This manual contains over 500 VEC and court cases that interpret the provisions of the Virginia Unemployment Compensation Act. This manual is a useful research tool, especially for claimants, employers, attorneys, and accountants.
- Case Decisions Guidance Documents - In addition to the Precedent Decision Manual, the VEC has identified a number of case decisions that are frequently cited in its opinions. These case decisions have been designated as guidance documents and are a useful supplement to the Precedent Decision Manual.
- Unpublished Court of Appeals Opinions.
- Online Mass Claims Filing - File unemployment insurance claims and payments on behalf of your employees that experience either a permanent or temporary layoff. This process is for EMPLOYER USE ONLY.
- File or Pay Your Taxes Online - I-Reg/I-File, your one stop for filing and/or paying your taxes and registering a new business.

Online Recruiting

As a partner in the Virginia Workforce Network, the Virginia Employment Commission is responsible for matching people with jobs using the Virginia Workforce Connection online system.

This link will take you to the Virginia Workforce Connection. A wide variety of powerful recruiting features are available to you after you register as an employer.

- You can post jobs online and choose whether or not to display your contact information.
- You can search locally, statewide, and nationally for job candidates.
- You can schedule automated candidate searches using the Virtual Recruiter.
- You can manage résumé search results by ranking and saving candidates to your favorites folder.
- You can create interview questions and required skills lists to add to your job posting.
- A shortcut is available to help you search for qualified veterans.
- You can link your recruiting website to the jobs you post.
- Real-time labor market information provides details about the available workforce.
